Welcome to the 2009 NHDC Allotments Newsletter!

Demand remains strong for allotment plots across the North Herts district.

There are presently 715 allotment plots in the urban areas of Hitchin, Baldock and Letchworth managed by NHDC.

About one third of current tenants have joined the allotment gardening community this last year alone!

The second phase of "Buzzworks" is now taking place with the construction of the Community Bee Garden, Discovery Centre and plant nursery. WREN (Landfill Tax Scheme) provided a grant of £25,000 towards the project.

Maintenance Works

Throughout the Autumn of 2008 extensive maintenance works took place on a number of sites.
