Flower seed sowing techniques

Method for perennials (HP) or hardy biennials (HB) for transplanting in the autumn.

Prepare a nursery bed in the same way that you would prepare the soil for sowing hardy annuals.

Mark out drills in the nursery bed again in the same way as for hardy annuals but the rows should be about 30cm apart and clearly labelled at the end.

Sow in the same way as for hardy annuals but once the true leaves have formed thin the plants to 10cm (4") apart and firm the soil around their bases.

In September or early October carefully raise the plants taking a ball of soil with the roots using a trowel and plant them in the flowering site and gently water them in. It is sometimes beneficial to give a little protection from winter winds for the first year.

Method for half hardy annuals (HHA) and perennials (HP and HHP) to be treated as HHA for flowering the same year, February to April.



Use seed trays or plastic modules and a good seedling compost, preferably using a peat substitute. For small sowings standard pots can be used.

Firm the compost lightly and moisten before sowing. Very fine seeds, like Begonia (where there are more than 60,000 seeds to a gram) should be mixed with dry horticultural sand to avoid one big clump of seed and to show where the seed has been sown.

As a general rule the depth of sowing depends on the size of the seed. Aim to cover the seed with compost or vermiculite to the same depth as the size of the seed. Very fine seed need not be covered at all.

Sow thinly and cover the tray with a sheet of glass with paper on the top. Wipe the glass every day and inspect the tray for signs of germination. Sowings in pots can be enclosed with a polythene bag for the same

As soon as seedlings break the surface remove the glass and paper or polythene bag, if left under glass they will become leggy and weak. Keep moist with a fine spray.

When the first set of true leaves, not the first seedling leaves, have formed they should be pricked off into trays setting the seedlings about 4-5cm (1½-2") apart. Always handle by the leaves not the stem and use a fork or knife blade to ease them out of the compost. Keep in shade for a couple of days after pricking off.

Gradually harden off the plants by increasing ventilation and moving the trays into a cold frame and finally outside for 7 days before transplanting into the flowering site.

Greenhouse plants whether perennial or annual should be treated as HHA.





Method for hardy annuals (HA) and half hardy annuals (HHA) for later flowering March and April or September for spring flowering.

Prepare the soil in the flowering site well in advance ensuring that all weeds are removed. Choose a time for sowing when the soil does not stick to your shoes but is moist below the surface and fairly dry on top. The soil should be crumbly and even. Rake the surface after a light treading.

Either mark small rows for sowing or mark an area for scattering seed to rake in afterwards. Hardy annuals should be sown to a depth of about twice the size of the seed. If the ground is dry water the rows before sowing not after.

Sow the seed carefully and thinly, aiming to get a seed about every 2cm (¾") and then gently rake the soil to cover and firm with the back of the rake. Water gently if the weather is dry for a period. Do not water too often as this will encourage roots to form just below the surface and you will be watering all summer long to save your plants. Aim to encourage the roots to go down looking for water and you will have a more relaxed summer and a finer show of flowers.

When the seedlings have formed the first pair of true leaves they should be thinned out and you can, by careful lifting of the excess plants, transplant them to other flowering sites.

Thin September sown seeds in about October or early November before they cease growth for the winter.
